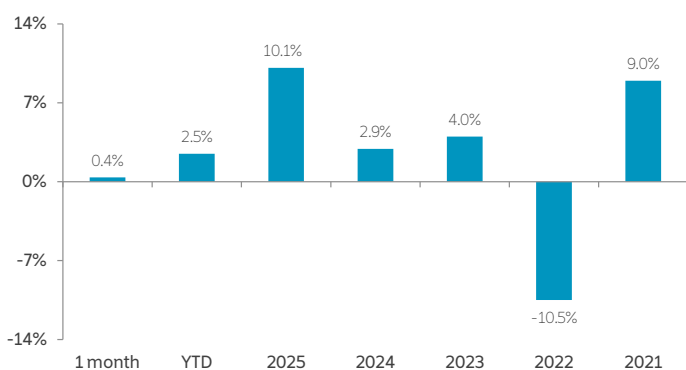

Cumulative returns (Class A - since inception, 12.08.2011)



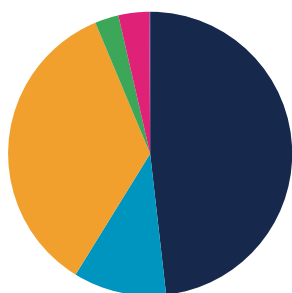

Manager commentary

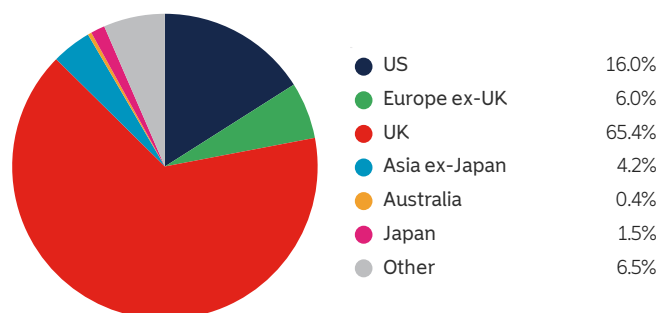
» In June, we made several adjustments to the Portfolio. We reduced both developed and emerging market equity exposure, taking profits following their strong performance so far this year, and reallocated capital across gold, hedge funds, high-yield bonds, convertible bonds and emerging market debt. The changes are intended to broaden diversification, reduce reliance on equity market returns and improve the Portfolio's resilience across a wider range of market outcomes. Gold and hedge funds provide differentiated sources of return and potential downside protection, while high-yield, convertible and emerging market bonds retain exposure to income, credit and market upside.

» Overall, the Portfolio has moved toward a more balanced risk profile, but this is not a fully defensive shift: we continue to maintain meaningful participation in growth assets while moderating equity concentration and locking in some recent gains.

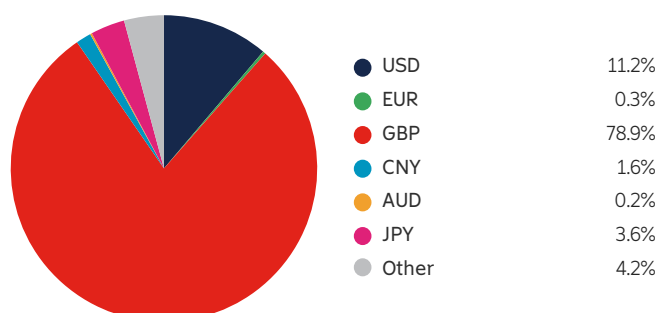
