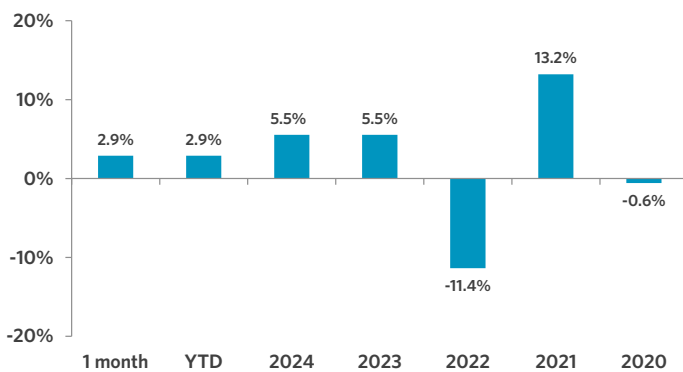

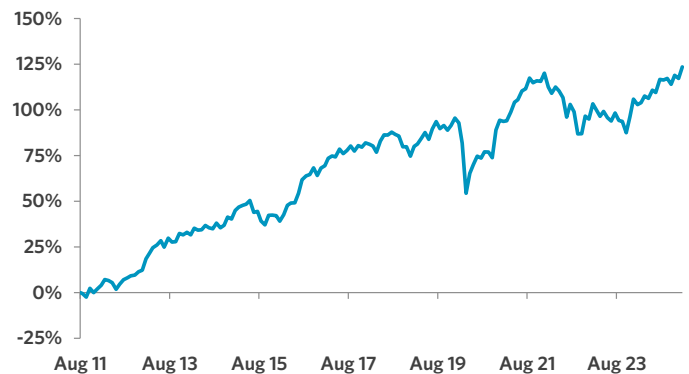

Cumulative returns (since Fund inception, 12.08.2011)**



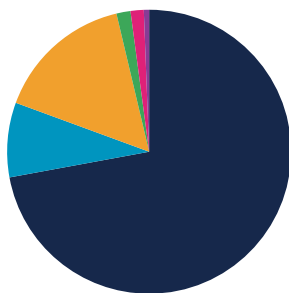

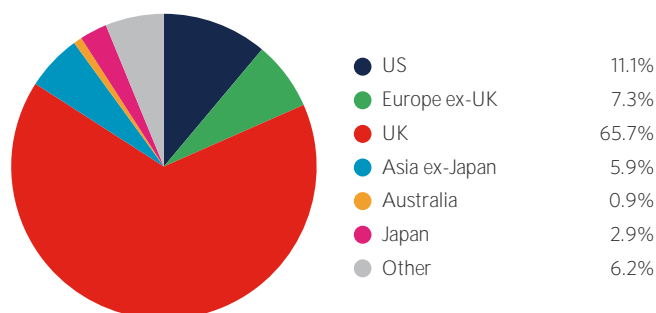

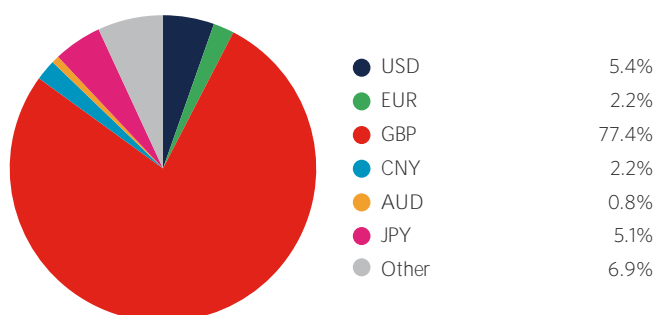
