Investment objective*

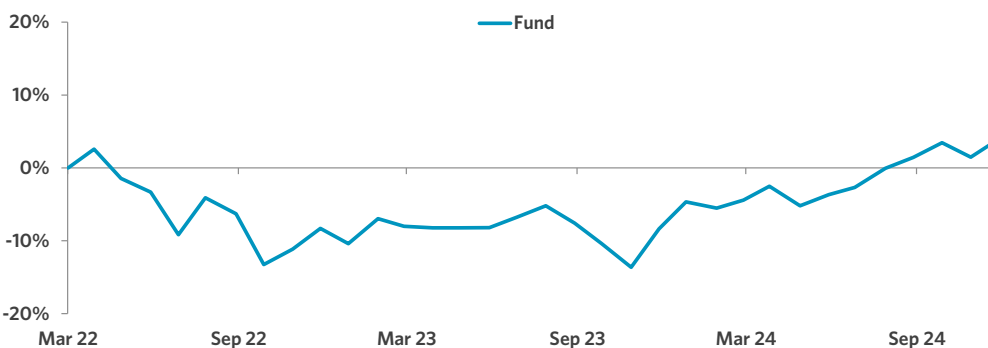
To provide capital growth in US Dollar terms but with a reduced level of volatility via strategic exposures to a wide range of asset classes. The Fund aims for a better sustainability profile compared to relevant broad market indices for the majority of asset class exposures by integrating ESG (i.e. Environmental, Social and corporate Governance) factors.

The Sub-fund takes sustainability risk and ESG characteristics into account as part of its selection process. In that respect, the Sub-fund promotes environmental and/or social characteristics within the meaning of Article 8 of SFDR. For the assessment, areas like corporate strategy, corporate governance, transparency and the product and service range of a company are taken into account. 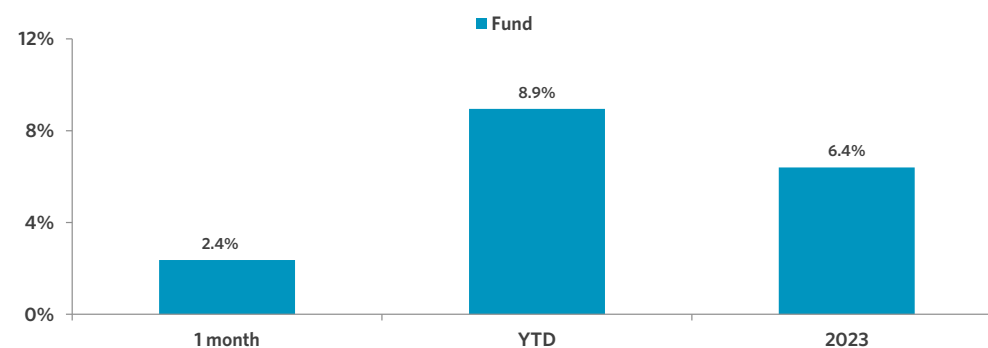
Manager commentary

- » In November, US markets significantly outperformed the rest of the world, with the S&P 500 reaching a new record high and delivering its strongest monthly performance of 2024. European sovereign bonds also fared well as investors anticipated accelerated rate cuts from the ECB. However, there were some areas of weakness. French assets lagged due to concerns over the country's budget, while the Euro experienced its sharpest decline against the US dollar in 18 months, driven by speculation about potential new tariffs. Additionally, the dollar's strength, coupled with broader weakness in other regions, led to negative returns for nearly all non-USD denominated risk assets in USD terms during the month.
- » Against this backdrop, we left asset allocation and manager selection unchanged.

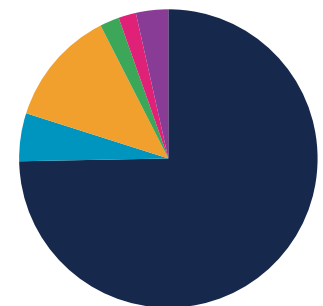

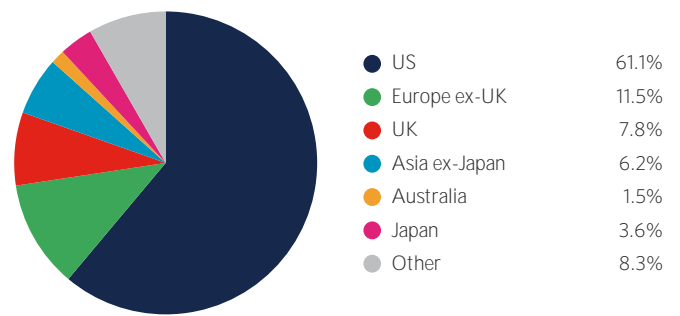

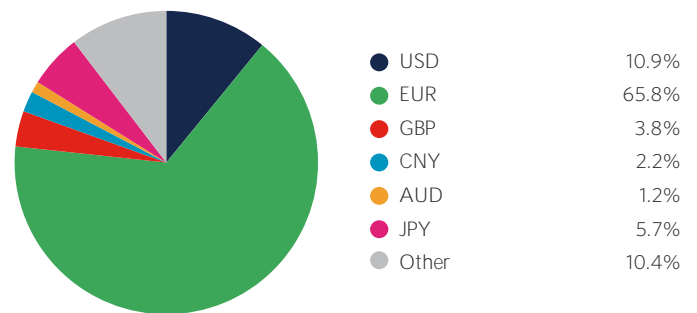

Geographic allocation



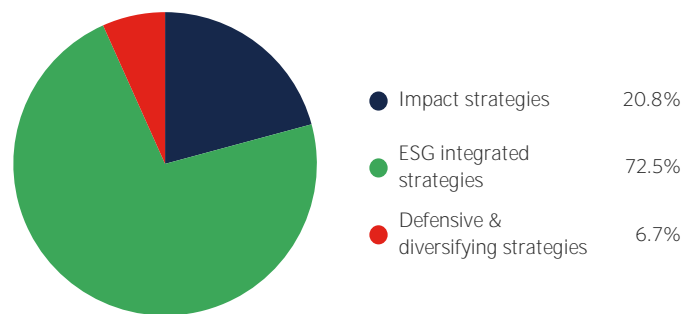
